

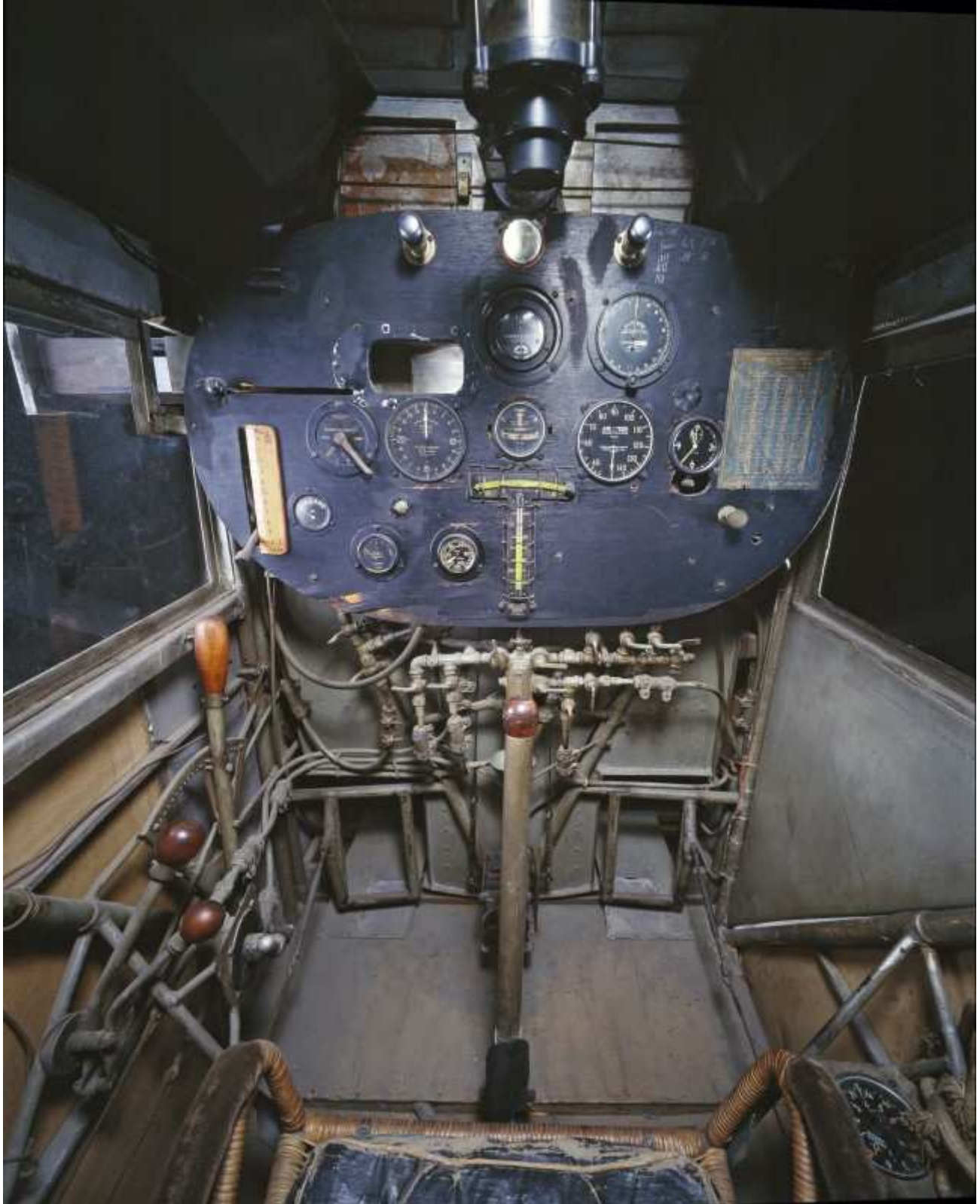
**Subject: Cockpits over the last 100+ years**

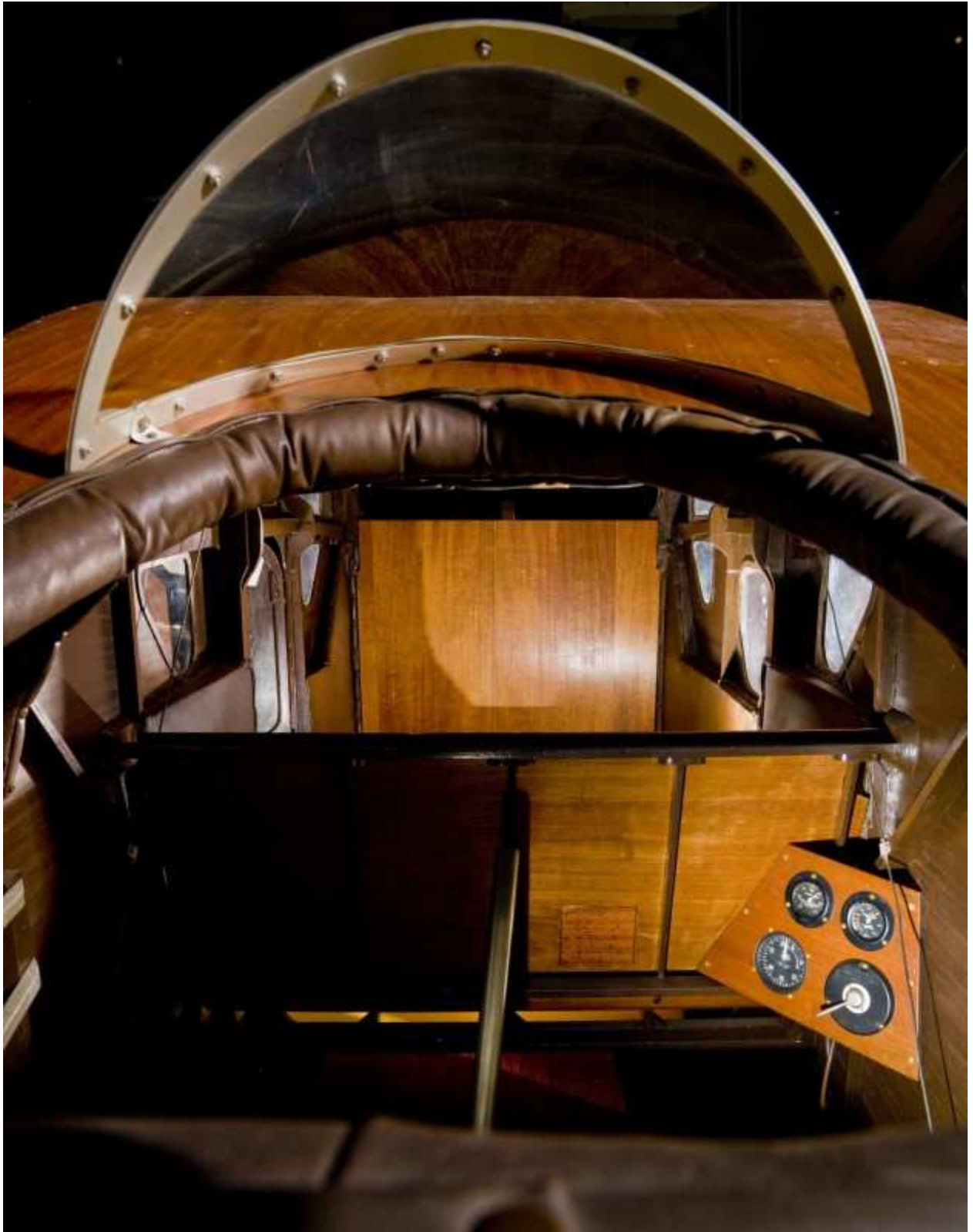

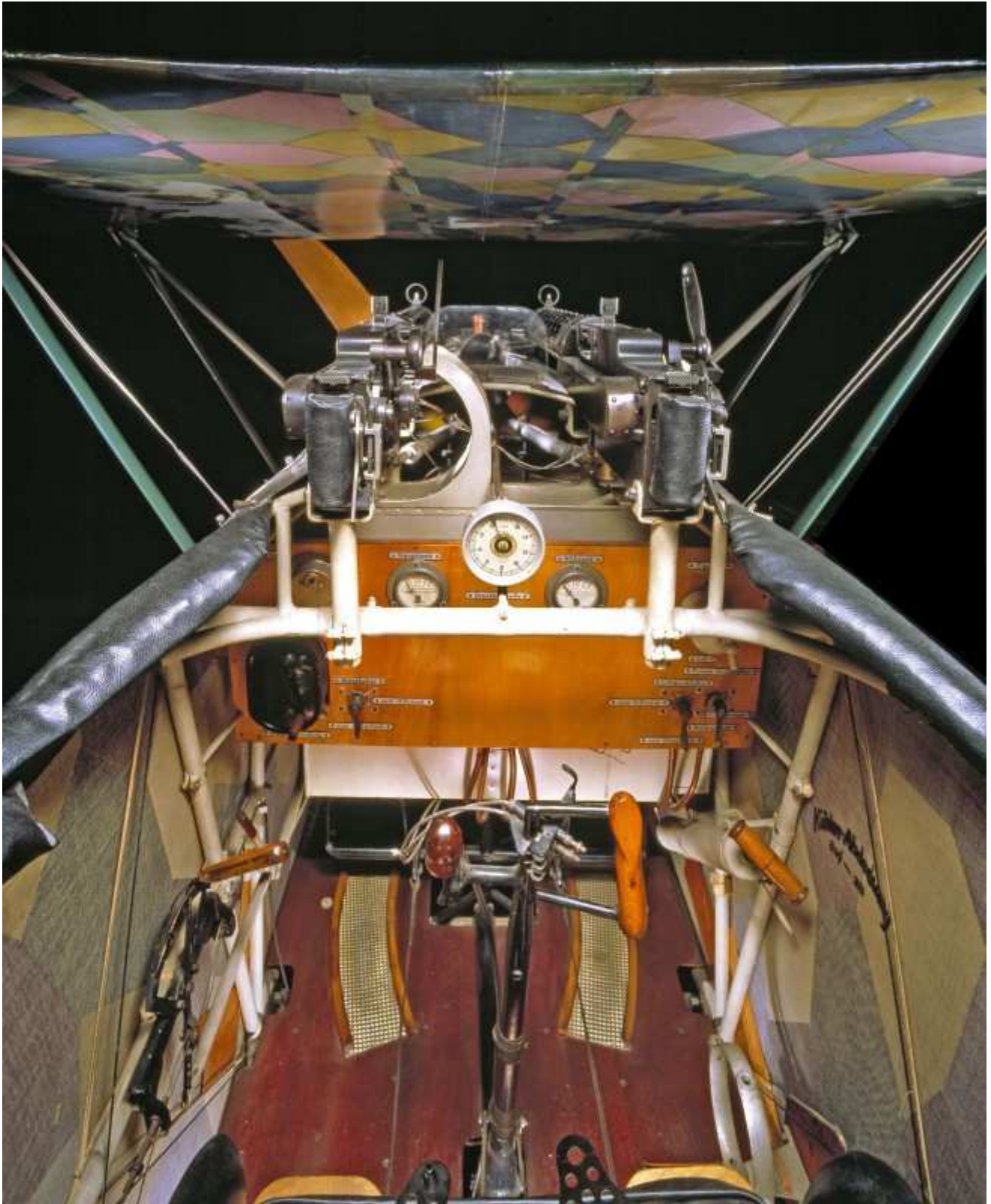
